- Administer, manage and audit loss control program for the project
- Assist with project and job site activities and ensure that the duties, responsibilities and authority are clearly defined
- Advise on hazard identification and control, inspections, investigations, reports, orientations, training requirements, project safety plans, early and safe return to work programs
- Review/perform/complete incident and inspection reports and ensure that corrective action and follow-up are taken

- Develop and maintain safe work practices and job procedures
- Ensure that appropriate practices and procedures are provided to supervisory staff
- Conduct random work site inspections and audits to ensure compliance with company policy and legislation

- Participate in Project JH&SC, Weekly Safety Meetings and Project Management meetings
- Liaise with MOL, MOE, WSIB and other government agencies as required
