To provide outreach, information, referrals, and advocacy services and to coordinate family support services for families of children with special needs.

A) Skills

- Self-motivation, able to work with minimal supervision.
- Demonstrated strong leadership skills in the area of work to be facilitated
- Excellent oral and written communication skills
- Excellent inter-personal and team skills

- Good computer skills.
- Demonstrated presentation and group facilitation skills.

B) Experience

- Bachelor's Degree in Social Science from an accredited university or 4 years related work experience along with a 2 year Diploma in a related field will be considered.
