Position:

The Education Assistant (EA) assists with the programming strategies as indicated on the Individual Education Plan (IEP) and as directed by the Special Needs Resource Teacher. The EA works collaboratively with classroom teachers, consultants and other Professional staff in accordance with the WIES policies and procedures handbook on Special Education.

Requirements:

- Post-Secondary Diploma in Early Childhood Education, Developmental Service Worker, Child and Youth Worker or related discipline
- High level of appreciation of Indigenous issues, particularly relating to youth
- Ability to offer support in challenging situations on a daily basis
- Ability to establish and maintain challenging relationships with school staff, students and their families
- High level of integrity, commitment and judgement, including the ability to deal with sensitive and confidential information
- Able to use heavy lifting methods and handle wheelchairs and change diapers
- Computer literate

Responsibilities:

- Responsible for supporting students on a one-on-one and providing classroom supports to the teacher for group-based instruction
